Peter Fox is a professor at Arizona State University where he has been a faculty member in the School of Sustainable Engineering and the Built Environment for 28 years and was director of the National Center for Sustainable Water Supply for eight years. Dr. Fox currently serves as the graduate chair for the School of Sustainable Engineering and the Built Environment Engineering. His professional interests are primarily in water reuse, biological treatment processes and combined biological/adsorptive systems and has focused his work on natural treatment systems, groundwater recharge and biofiltration for the last fifteen years. More recently, Dr. Fox has been researching novel brine disposal technologies and physical water treatment.

Dr. Fox was an executive committee member for the development of the "National Roadmap for Desalination and Water Purification". He served on the National Academy of Science ad-hoc committee that published the National Research Council report entitled "Prospects for Managed Underground Storage of Recoverable Water" in 2008.
